TERRARIUM

Cutting

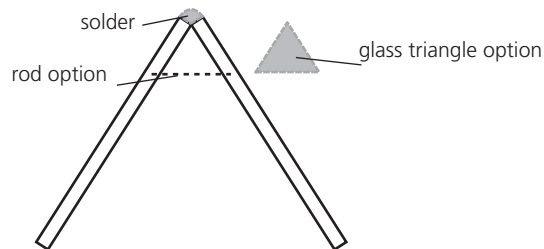
From single strength glass, cut two of this pentagon shape.

In addition, you will need:
One piece 6¼" x 10" for the bottom
Two pieces 7" x 10" for the sides
Two pieces 5½" x 12" for the roof

Accuracy in cutting is essential, as inaccuracies will prevent the project from fitting together properly.

Assemble the body of the terrarium as you would a box.

Assemble the roof separately. To add stability to the roof, solder small pieces of hinge rod to the roof, or cut a piece of clear glass to fit the peak and solder it to the roof.



Be very careful when cleaning as the terrarium will be fragile. Make sure it is completely clean of flux and patina before planting the terrarium. Enjoy!
